? What is It


A diagram that examines **why something happened** or **might happen** by organizing potential causes into **smaller categories**.


When

- Identify the or multiple root causes and areas for improvement.
- Facilitate brainstorming for problem solving.
- To pair with the 5 Why's methodology.
- Used in the Analyze phase of the DMAIC.

Goals

- Visual Tool to understand and analyze a problem.
- Locate the **bottleneck** in the process.
- Educates teams to have in-depth discussions and understanding.
 - Prioritize corrective actions.





Root Cause for People Cause 2: Root Cause for Method Cause 3: Root Cause for Culture Cause 1:






Democratically selecting the cause, which may **not be the most effective** process.
