Instructions:

- 1. In pairs, have a walk to the production area, shop floor, warehouse, store floor, hospital area.
- 2. Print the Process Walk (Gemba Walk) template and complete the header: Business Unit, Work area, who is assessing and when.
- 3. Perform a Gemba Walk focused on WIP accumulation in between stations and/or process steps. Consider looking for Inventory (WIP) and Overproduction Waste.
- 4. Consider that the process observed may not apply to the one piece flow concept. Consider also that the process may be a "small-batch flow".
- 5. Identify is there is Internal Lot Size (Transfer batch).
- 6. Try to identify if the stations receive excessive/not required materials and if the stations generating the finish products accumulate excessively.
- 7. Try to identify if is possible to build a smoother, connected flow between each process step by targeting the flow and WIP buildup within the workstations.
